
Sir,

In continuation to our letter cited above, I am directed to forward herewith the UC for the amount of Rs.25695.793 lakh out of grant of Rs.34860.00 lakh released by Government of India till date under the award of Twelfth Finance Commission in a consolidated statement at **Annexure -II**. These constitute 73.71% of TFC grants released to the State Government. State Government has now attained 70% of grants released by the Government of India in terms of Government of India's letter No.12 (6)/FCD/2005 dt.5.10.2009. Till date State Government has released Rs.34095.00 lakh to local bodies, which constitute 97.80 % of total fund released by Government of India.

In addition to that, SFC Cell in Finance Department has transferred interest amount of Rs.484.40 lakh to local bodies on account of delayed release of grants beyond stipulated 15 days equal to the RBI bank rate.

In view of above, you are requested to kindly release the balance installments of grant under award of TFC for local bodies for the years 2008-09 and 2009-10.
